*and Church Growth "And the surveys say....."*

The Evangelism and Church Growth Division thanks all that submitted a response to our recent survey. Here is a summary of the responses.

1. How and when in your life did your involvement start with FCC? Responses were from a good cross-section of life-time members, all the way to more recent new members in the past few years. Some came when they were searching for a church, some came with a spouse, some were here from birth.

2. What do you like best about FCC and what keeps you here? Many noted Pastor Steve and Mariah and their ministries. Also many responses about feeling of family, relationships, friendliness, a sense of belonging and comfort, and the praying for others. Also noted were responses on progressive attitudes, openness to diversity and thinking for oneself, a mix of old and new traditions.

3. What would you like to see start and/or grow here at FCC to keep it alive and growing? Many noted areas of keeping people involved, such as small groups, Bible studies and educational series, a growing Sunday School for youth and adults, church dinners, a men's group, monthly family events. Also ranking high was the importance of supporting youth activities and also growing our young adult/young family population. And frequently mentioned was a return of the choir.

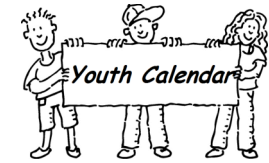
